SHOW SCHEDULE

Class number

- 1 Any cactus in a pot no more than 3 inches across
- 2 Any cactus in a pot no more than 5 inches across
- 3 Any cactus that is globular in shape
- 4 Any cactus that is columnar or elongated in shape
- 5 Any cactus in flower
- 6 Any other succulent in a pot no more than 3 inches across
- 7 Any other succulent in a pot no more than 5 inches across
- 8 Any other succulent forming a clump
- 9 Any other succulent with a swollen root
- 10 Any other succulent in flower

No exhibit shall be in a pot larger than 6 inches across. If you are unsure about any of these classes please ask for guidance. We all grow these plants for enjoyment so bring some to show the rest of us what you have.
